4. Entrances are at Yen-ping South Road and at Chang-sha Road. Visitors will have their identity checked by the site administrator before entering and will follow a planned visit route. During the visit, please don't make noise, linger, trespass on grass, or enter restricted areas.
5. The residence is a heritage site. The company reserves the right to take legal action against the visitors who cause damage to the site, its objects and plants within the site.
6. No parking service is offered at the heritage site. Visitors are advised to take public transport:
